This agreement, entered into as of the _____ day of _____, is between _____, thereafter referred to as "Coach", an individual serving the Texas United Football Club. The Coach represents that he/she is qualified and desires to perform the services required by the Club. The term is for ONE TUFU fiscal year that runs from July 1st to June 30th. Either party can terminate this agreement with 10 days written notice to the other party.

I agree that I will abide by the rules of TUFU. Recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with soccer, and in consideration for TUFU accepting the registrant for its soccer programs and activities (the "Programs") hereby release, discharge and/or otherwise indemnify TUFU and associated personnel, including the owners of the fields, and facilities utilized for the Programs, against any claim by or on behalf of the registrant as a result of the registrant's participation in the Programs and/or being transported to or from the same, which transportation I hereby authorize.

It is the intent of the TUFU to accept coaches, referees, administrators and volunteers without a prior history of violence, child abuse or neglect. The information given in this statement is subject to verification. This may include a criminal history check, verification of your motor vehicle record or publically available background check. The answers to these questions are truthful and correct.

As a condition of volunteering, I give permission for TUFU to conduct a background check on me, which may include a review of sex offender registries, child abuse, and criminal history records. I understand that, if appointed, my position is conditional upon the league receiving no inappropriate information on my background. I hereby release and agree to hold harmless from liability TUFU, the officers, employees, and volunteers thereof, or any other person or organization that may provide such information. I also understand that, regardless of previous appointments, TUFU is not obligated to appoint me to a volunteer position. If appointed, I understand that, prior to the expiration of my term, I am subject to suspension by the Director of Coaches & Trainers (DOCT) and removal by the Board of Directors for violation of TUFU policies and principles.

In consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. **All TUFU Coaches are volunteers and will not get paid for their services. Nor will they use any paid soccer trainers other than one of the approved soccer training firm's listed below. If they violate this agreement they can be fined, suspended, or removed as Coach by the D&P Committee or Board of Directors.**
 - Sports Quest
 - Elite Soccer
 - Premier Soccer
2. The Coach will make a good faith effort to attend all coaches meetings, seminars, clinics and tryouts which are established by the Club. It is the obligation of the Coach to advise the Club if an event cannot be attended.
3. Training sessions in which the Coach leads the session will be run in a positive, structured, professional, healthy, manner, stressing soccer skills and tactics. The Coach will be evaluated annually and his or her position will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. The retention on the Coach shall be solely with discretion of the DOCT & BOD.
4. Competitive level coaches U11 and above are required to hold or obtain an age appropriate license, or E level license, or above.
5. The Coach is responsible for knowledge of the rules as defined by HYSA, EDDOA, STYSA, USSF or any other affiliated organization. Coaches are expected to follow all rules and regulations.
6. The Coach will be required to wear Texas United Football Club approved coaching/training gear at all TUFU games including tournaments. (ONE Coaching shirt will be provided to the head coach)
7. The Coach is required to abide by TUFU 30/30 Lightning Policy. See TUFU web-site for details.
8. The Coach is required to help run the annual tryouts for TUFU and all players on their teams are expected to participate.
